'Normativity and Nature: Prospects for a Stereoscopic View

This paper further explores problems and prospects for a 'stereoscopic' view that would simultaneously defend the constitutive role of normativity in all human conceptual cognition (for reasons variously articulated by philosophers strongly influenced by Kant, Hegel, pragmatism, or Sellars) along with a version of the kind of comprehensive explanatory naturalism that is usually taken to be incompatible with that role.
